

At-Risk Plan Earlham School District K-12

Last updated: 2015

The Earlham Community School District will identify students based off building level at-risk criteria, as well as the Department of Education's criteria. The process of identifying students, as well as programming for students, will be determined and carried out at the building level Building Assistance Team (BAT) meetings. The teams are made up of building administrators, school counselors, and success and at-risk coordinators. The teams will meet as often as they see fit, minimum of once monthly, in order to review referrals made by staff, discuss students identified, and evaluate current programming.

Department of Education Standards ~

The DOE states that a student is a potential drop out if they meet two or more of the following criteria:

- Attendance - 89% or below
- Behavior - no connection/many office referrals
- Course Completion - failed credits
- Scores - two or more grade levels below in math and or reading
