

HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2016-17

All Classes - Headphones/earbuds and flash drive (USB)

- English, Science and Spanish all require a 3-ring binder and loose-leaf paper. A 2" binder should work for all three classes. Tabbed dividers would be essential if you are going to use the binder for all three classes.

Math Department - Mr. Gilson and Mrs. Connon (Geometry)

- Pre-Algebra: Notebook, scientific calculator, pencils, small ruler or protractor (should measure inches and centimeters)
- Algebra 1: Same as Pre-Algebra
- Geometry: In addition to the above; binder/folder for keeping notes and homework, notebook paper, two different colored writing utensils, compass (if you don't like computer versions).

English Department - Mrs. Johnson

- English 1: Tabbed dividers, loose-leaf paper, two-pocket folder, flash drive (for storing work/writing projects so students can take it to and from school for homework), highlighter, pen and pencil

Science Department - Mrs. Mendoza

- Physical Science: Loose-leaf paper, pens, pencils, highlighter. Index cards and post-it notes are extremely helpful but not required.
- FRESHMAN ONLY: 1 in. or larger binder, 8 or more dividing tabs, loose leaf notebook paper, pens and pencils, white out, highlighters, hole reinforcement labels, index cards for flash cards, colored pencils, pencil bag.

Spanish Department - Ms. Michel

- Spanish 1: Two dry-erase markers, loose-leaf paper, notebook, flash drive (USB), Spanish-English dictionary or Dictionary Notebook (optional), 3x5 index cards (optional)

Art Department - Mr. von Rentzell

- Art 1: \$10 fee includes sharpie marker, set of 12 tubes of acrylic paint, a paintbrush and paint palette. Other supplies that could be purchased are a set of drawing pencils with erasers for about \$3.00.
- Art 2: \$10 fee includes three rolls of packing tape per student, metal for jewelry project and miscellaneous consumable items.

Any project has some sort of expense to it. The school covers the basics but just like any shop or home economics project, the student is expected to spend money on projects that they possibly will use in their personal lives.
