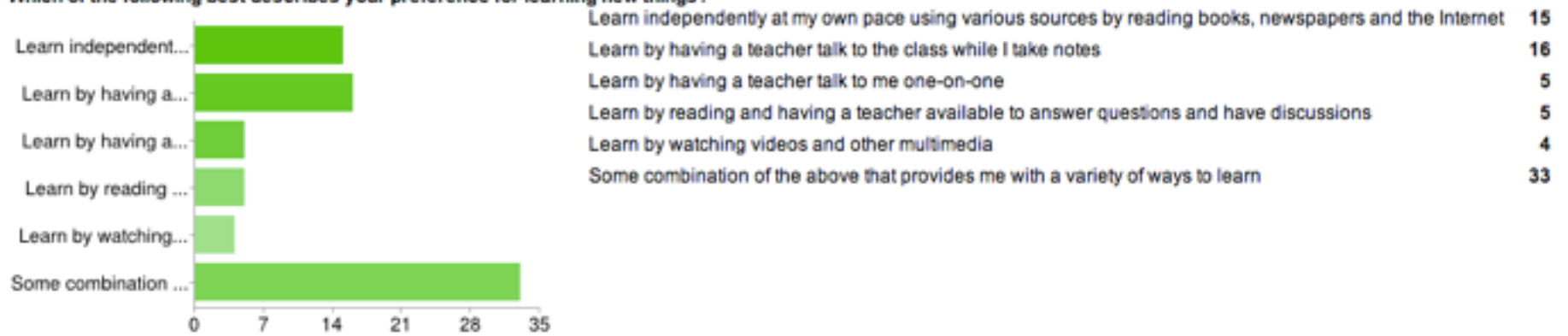

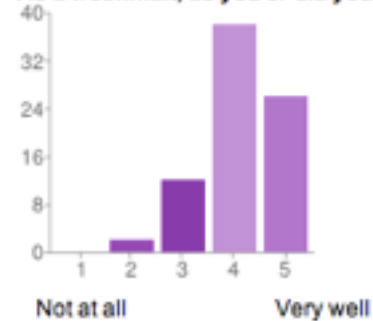

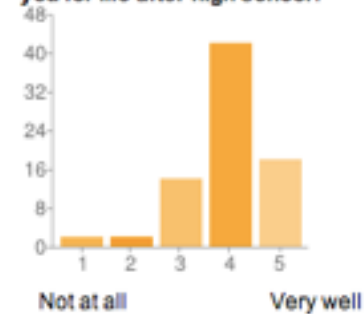

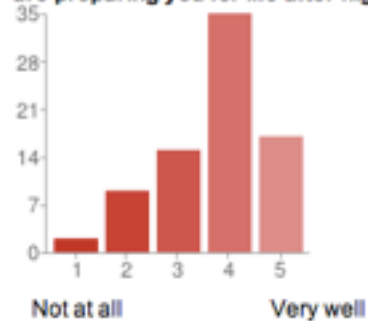

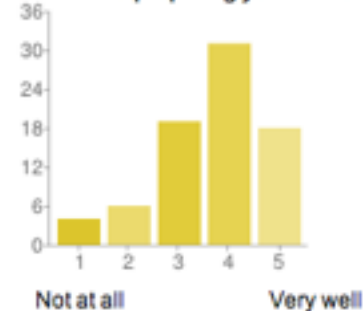
**How well do you think the technology skills you are learning are preparing you for life after high school?**



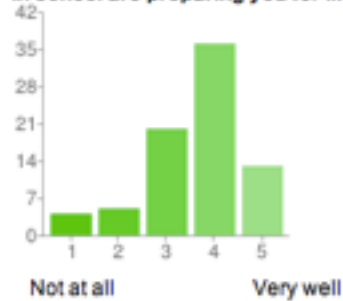
**How well do you think the organizational skills you are learning in school are preparing you for life after high school?**



**How well do you think the time management skills you are learning in school are preparing you for life after high school?**



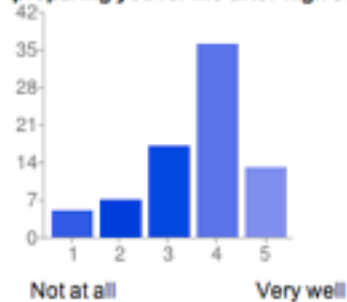
How well do you think the written communications skills you are learning in school are preparing you for life after high school?



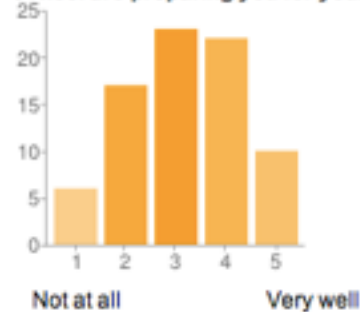
How well do you think the oral communication skills you are learning in school are preparing you for life after high school?



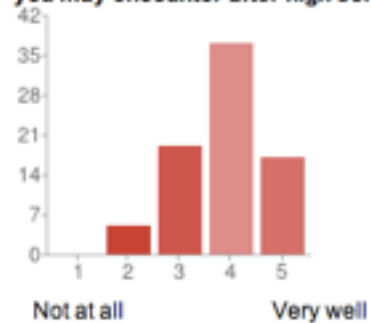

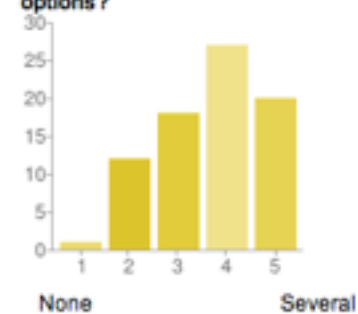

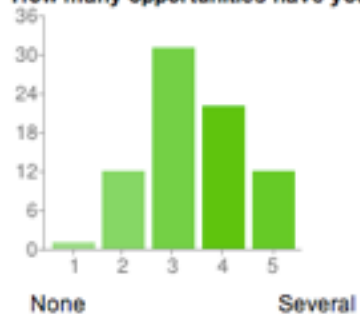
How well prepared do you think you will be to solve new problems that you may encounter after high school?

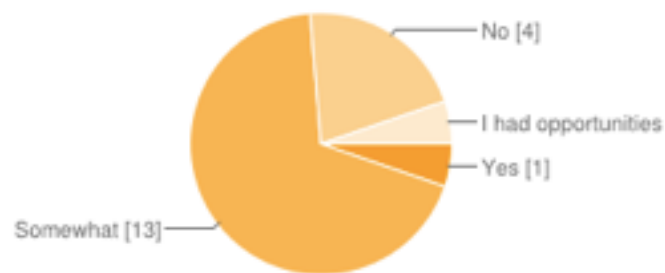

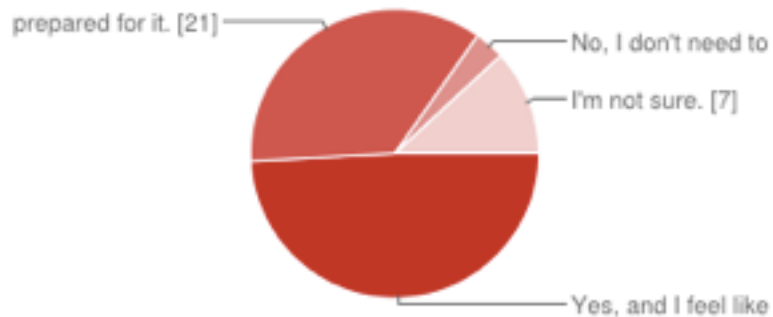

**Did you feel academically prepared to do well on the ACT?**

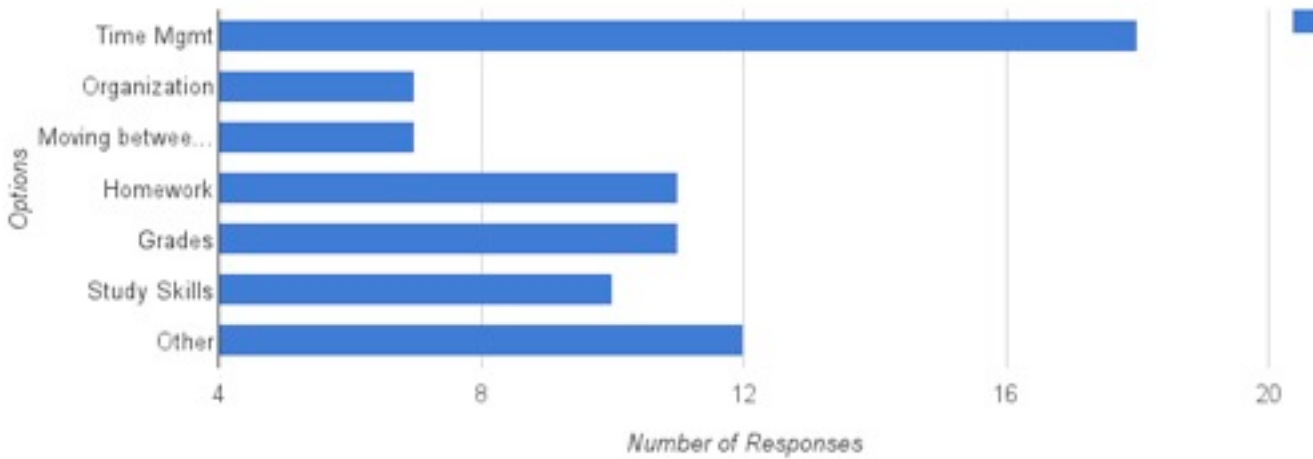


**Do you plan on taking the ACT in the future?**
