High School Goals

Academic Goals

1. 80% of 9th, 85% of 10th, 65% of 11th, and 65% of 12th graders will earn a 2.0/C- or better in all classes each semester.
2. 80% of 9th, 85% of 10th, and 90% of 11th students will be proficient or above on the Iowa Assessment Reading test.

Climate Goals

89% participation rate in one extra-curricular activity and 70% participation rate in two extra-curricular activities.

Middle School Goals

Academic Goal

90% of Earlham Middle School students will meet or exceed the national norm or will show growth in three of the four MAP tests (measured Fall to Spring).

Climate Goal

80% of all middle school students will be members of the Cardinal Club, which will monitor academic success as well as behavior.

District Goals

Early Literacy: 90% of K-3 students will be proficient on the FAST Spring Benchmark Assessment.

Reading: 87% of students in grades 3-11 will be proficient on the Iowa Assessment Reading Test.

Math: 90% of students in grades 3-11 will be proficient on the Iowa Assessment Mathematics Test.

Science: Grades 3-11 will be proficient on the Iowa Assessment Science Test.

Elementary Goals

Academic Goal

- Preschool - 90% of students will be able to identify 20/26 uppercase letters and 18/26 lowercase letters. 90% of students will be able to produce 15/26 letter sounds.
- Kindergarten - Reading: Students will end the year at level D with 90% accuracy. Math: 80% of students will meet their individual target growth from fall '16 to spring '17 on MAP math test.
- 1st grade - Reading: 90% of students will accurately read sight words on the FAST assessment. 85% of students will read 70 WPM on the Spring FAST assessment.
- 2nd grade - Reading: 90% of students will meet the accuracy goal of 95% on the FAST assessment. Math: 85% of students will show growth from fall to winter and winter to spring on MAP math test.
- 3rd grade - Reading: FAST focus on showing growth in words. Math: 85% of students will show growth from fall to winter and winter to spring on MAP math test.
- 4th, 5th & 6th grade - Reading: 85% of students will show growth from the fall '16 to spring '17 on MAP reading test. Math: 85% of students will show growth from the fall '16 to spring '17 on MAP math test.
